

  - **\$26,266,800 provided in grants**







### Crusader's Cross





The Jewel comes in 5 levels, \$1,000, \$2,000, \$3000, \$4,000 and \$5,000 or above. The \$1,000 level has the single, larger cross in the center. Each additional \$1,000 is identified with an additional small cross in a quadrant until at \$5,000 or above all four quadrants are occupied to complete the emblem known as the Crusader's Cross also known as the Cross of Jerusalem.




