

Grand Commandery Annual Returns

Section 41 Grand Commandery

(h): It shall, on or before July 1st of each year pay to the Grand Recorder of the Grand Encampment such an amount as may be prescribed by the Grand Encampment as dues for each member of its Constituent Commanderies, as shown by the returns of

Constituent Commanderies, as shown by the returns of such Grand Commandery as of December 31st.

NOTE -- AMENDED 2015

Amendment No. 2015-05 ADOPTED 2015

Requires Grand Recorder to file Annual Returns on prescribed forms

Assesses \$500 penalty for late, inaccurate or incomplete Annual Returns

Section 52 Grand Recorder

It is the duty of the Grand Recorder...

(b) To forward to the Grand Recorder of the Grand Encampment, on or before the First Day of July of each year, the Annual Returns and Dues of the Grand Commandery.

NOTE -- AMENDED 2015

Amendment No. 2015-04 ADOPTED 2015

Requires Grand Recorder to file Annual Returns on prescribed forms

Assesses \$500 penalty for late, inaccurate or incomplete Annual Returns

Requires Grand Recorder to forward required forms within thirty (30) days of Annual Conclave

Recapitulation (Reporting) Period January 1 – December 31

Due in Grand Encampment Office on or before July 1

NOTE -- PENALTY FOR LATE, INACCURATE OR INCOMPLETE RETURNS

Electronic Reporting will be implemented when <u>ALL</u> Commanderies are using MMS

Grand Master Goodwin's Decision No. 11:

RE: Orders, Address Changes, Status Changes, Deaths, etc.

Each Commandery Recorder and Grand Commandery Grand Recorder is responsible for entering information...within 15 days of the occurrence.

Amendment No. 2015-06 ADOPTED 2015

Requires Constituent (or Subordinate) Recorder to issue a Grand Encampment Dues Card to all Sir Knights of his Commandery

Bears Seal of the Grand Encampment and the Attestation of the Grand Recorder of the Grand Encampment

QUORUM

Section 66

A quorum of a Commandery consists of nine members entitled to vote therein, including an Officer authorized to open the same.

Section 66 continued...

A Grand Commandery may by law provide for a lesser number for quorum purposes, provided the number is no lower than five.

Section 66 now reads:

A quorum of a Commandery consists of nine members entitled to vote therein, including an Officer authorized to open the same. A Grand Commandery may by law provide for a lesser number for quorum purposes, provided the number is no lower than five.

Nelson Decision No. 1 - Quorum

Section 66 allows a Grand Commandery to reduce the number of Sir Knights necessary to constitute a quorum for conducting the business of the Commandery to a number less than nine but not less than five.

Nelson Decision No. 1 - Continued

A Grand Commandery may only implement this provision legislatively.

CONTINUED ON NEXT SLIDE

Nelson Decision No. 1 - Continued

Nine Sir Knights constitute a Commandery and are required to establish a Commandery or confer the Orders of Knighthood.

Passage of Proposed Amendment 2018-09 as amended

CORDS (PURPLE)

Section 306

(b) The Jewel of Office of Past Grand Commanders may be worn suspended from a heavy, royal purple silk cord with swivel; the cord to have a tassel at the ends to be held together by sliding holders with rosette.

Passage of Proposed Amendment 2018-10

Section 244

Adds "SILVER" and changes "HALO" to "RAYS" in description of embroidered emblem on Commander's shoulder boards

Passage of Proposed Amendment 2018-12

Section 114 MILEAGE & PER DIEM

Shortens and clarifies Section 114

Payment of Mileage and Per Diem for Grand Encampment Triennial Conclaves

Standing Resolution

1976 Master Ritual (full English with limited distribution)

1979 Ritual (coded portions)

Standing Resolution

Resolved, that the Right Eminent Grand Recorder, in association with the Committee on Ritualistic Matters, be directed to reprint and republish the Master Ritual correcting any minor scrivener's errors.

Standing Resolution continued

This reprint will replace the 1976 Master Ritual and the 1979 coded Ritual as the Official Ritual of the Grand Encampment.

Grand Encampment Rituals

Can be ordered only by <u>Grand Recorders</u>

(multiples of 10)

May be shipped and billed to Constituent Commanderies

Recognition of GE KT USA – PHA

Committee on Foreign Relations

GE KT USA – PHA

Does not automatically establish mutual recognition and visitation by the respective Grand Commanderies.

GE KT USA – PHA

Each Grand Commandery may extend recognition and/or visitation privileges by legislative process...

GE KT USA – PHA

...based upon the rules and regulations promulgated by the Grand Lodge of their jurisdiction.

Invasion of Territory

Violation of Treaty of Amity or Concordat of 1910

Nelson General Order No. 4 GREECE - CONTINUED

"I, as Grand Master of the Grand Encampment of Knights Templar of the United States of America, hereby SUSPEND recognition of and fraternal relations with the Grand Encampment Knights Templar of Greece and Cyprus."

Nelson General Order No. 5 MEMBERSHIP

is PRIORITY ONE
during the 68th Triennium

Nelson General Order No. 5 MEMBERSHIP - CONTINUED

Every Grand Commander shall appoint a Membership Chairman and Membership Committee in each Grand Jurisdiction.

Every Eminent Commander shall appoint a Membership Chairman and Membership Committee in each Commandery.

Nelson General Order No. 5 MEMBERSHIP - CONTINUED

Membership Committees shall work with and implement those membership development initiatives advanced by the Grand Encampment's Committee on Membership.

Nelson General Order No. 5 MEMBERSHIP - CONTINUED

Membership Committees shall report their activities and progress to their appointing authority and the Grand Encampment's Committee on Membership periodically on forms developed for this purpose by the Grand Encampment's Committee on Membership.
